Sapling Distribution Programme Under Development Action Plan for Scheduled Caste











Between 11.07.2025 and 01.08.2025, sapling distribution campaigns were organized at ICAR-National Institute on Foot and Mouth Disease, ICFMD, Arugul Bhubaneswar to the families of Scheduled caste community. The programme was conducted with an Idea to create awareness about plantation in general and plantation of fruit plants in special. This will address the basic needs of the SC communities in the lower strata of the society, so that an appreciable change in their income and green initiatives can be encouraged and observed that can be reflected in their standard of living and the livelihood earnings by providing such inputs that was a healthier initiative for environment too. Saplings included mango, jackfruit, guava, lemon and drumstick and all these were distributed to each SC beneficiary. During this series of programmes, a total of 401 SC Families were benefitted from 2 districts, 4 blocks, 14 Gram Panchyats and 28 villages. This programme was organized by the Nodal Officer Dr. Manoranjan Rout. In the programme, Director Dr. R.P. Singh, Dr. J.K. Mohapatra, Dr. S. Subrmaniam, Dr. N.R. Sahoo and other scientists were present.
